ABSENTEE VOTING PROCEDURES



PURPOSE

The intention of these procedures is to provide direction on collection of votes in advance of a meeting where multiple members are entitled to vote but some may not be able to be present at the time of the meeting.

APPLICATION

These procedures apply to all voting members of Alongside Hope.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

- By-Law No.1 Clause 4.09 permits voting members to appoint proxies to attend annual or other such meetings.
- A proxy need not be a member of the Corporation.
- All proxies must have accessible working email addresses.
- Proxies will attend the meeting and act in the manner and to the extent authorized by the member.
- Alongside Hope does not permit abstentions except by reason of conflict of interest which must be declared 24 hours in advance to the Secretary of the Corporation.
- In the event that a decision is made to collect votes in advance of a meeting, that decision will include the provision that motions cannot be amended on the floor of the meeting.
- Absentee (proxy) votes may not be used to establish a quorum.

ABSENTEE VOTING

- In the event of a decision to collect absentee votes from the members, the ballot will be designed in a manner similar to the sample in the Appendix and must be filed with the Secretary of the Corporation at least 24 hours before the beginning of the meeting.
- A voting member who will be in attendance at the meeting may be named as a proxy holder.
- There can be multiple proxy holders.
- Employees of Alongside Hope may not be proxy holders.
- Rather than proxy voting, an electronic voting platform may be used to collect votes during or in advance of a meeting, subject to prior Board approval.
- Care will be taken to exclude the possibility of abstentions.

DEFINITIONS

Proxy: a person who exercises the voting rights of a member according to instructions received from that member.

Proxy holder: A voting member of the Corporation who will be in attendance at the meeting and exercising a proxy of a member who is not in attendance.

Proxy vote: An absentee ballot of an Alongside Hope member deposited at least 24 hours advance of a meeting.

Absentee: A person entitled to attend the meeting who is not present during the meeting.
