

Gender Education in El Salvador

In rural areas of El Salvador, traditional gender norms continue to limit the possibility of establishing relationships based on respect and equity. This reality particularly affects young people, who grow up with restricted concepts of personal expression and social coexistence. The lack of open dialogue about consent and equality contributes to the reproduction of stereotypes, increasing vulnerability to violence and abuse.

The partnership between Alongside Hope and CoCoSi promotes spaces for training and dialogue in schools and rural communities in the department of Cabañas, involving the entire educational community (students, families, and teaching staff) in educational processes that promote healthy relationships. Activities include workshops, parental support groups, and youth awareness campaigns that strengthen the commitment to gender equality in their communities.

The objective is to provide communities with tools and knowledge that strengthen their capacity to prevent and respond to discrimination and violence. Each intervention seeks to create environments where children and young people develop skills for decision-making and the defense of their rights.
