In communities worldwide, climate change, conflict and economic instability make it hard for people to earn an income. Alongside Hope partners are able to support livestock programs, where goats, chickens, cows and other animals can improve nutrition by producing milk or eggs, as well as meat. Surplus protein items or livestock manure can also be sold to increase income, which provides stability and financial strength for the farmers. Many programs also provide instruction in beekeeping, which benefits farmers who can sell honey and supports plant pollination. Agricultural programs teach farmers to use climate-smart techniques that improve their incomes.
