## Malnourished no more

In Burundi, Alongside Hope is supporting Village Health Works to produce nutritious porridge locally. The peanut porridge is fortified with milk powder, oil and other nutrients and is a life-saving tool for treating malnutrition in children under five. The Magara Meza production facility will be running in 2026 and will reduce reliance on foreign supply chains.

## Muletime wishes

In rural Kenya, a donkey can make everyday life a little easier. By carrying heavy loads of water, firewood, or building materials, donkeys ease the burden on women, children, and the elderly. They support families who might otherwise struggle with daily chores, and can even help generate income through transport work.

## Know the drill

In Zimbabwe, a borehole well means safe, reliable water — right where it's needed most. A deep shaft taps into underground water, which is pumped using solar power into a large tank and piped directly to homes and livestock. It's a lifeline for communities that often rely on unsafe or distant water. While one borehole costs \$21,000, every gift brings families one step closer to long-lasting, clean water.

## A swale idea!

Heavy rains can wash away precious soil and flood farmland, but simple tools can make a big difference. Swales are shallow trenches that slow down rainwater, helping it soak into the ground instead of rushing away. Gabions are strong wire baskets filled with rocks. They hold hillsides in place to protect local land from erosion.

## Milking made better

A well-designed cow shelter offers shade, clean water, forage and protection, which leads to improved yields. Farmers can manage their cows more easily and keep them healthier for longer.

## Buzzing with excitement

In rural Colombia, a single beehive can do more than make honey. It gives a woman the chance to build income alongside others in her community. While she harvests and sells the honey, the bees quietly pollinate nearby crops, boosting the quality of the fruits and food.

## Hens forth

In Marsabit County, Kenya, unprecedented drought has plunged the community into food insecurity. Alongside Hope, with the Canadian Foodgrains Bank, is supporting a Church World Service program to provide 990 families with hens and roosters.

In Uganda, St. Judy Family Projects invest in local food security by teaching children how to feed the soil so it feeds the community. Children learn how to design circular gardens that look like mandalas, creating interest and also retaining the water. Here they're digging a round garden that will retain moisture for the banana tree that will be planted in the centre.



## Popping up

TSURO Trust is helping farmers in Zimbabwe build mushroom houses — simple sheds that become hands-on classrooms for growing mushrooms. Oyster mushrooms are a climate-smart crop that can boost nutrition and income, especially for women and families in need.

In Lesotho, Partners In Health supports new moms at the Bobete Maternity Clinic by providing essential items like a receiving blanket, onesie, sweater, cloth diapers and a hat. These kits are distributed to moms who have attended at least four antenatal care visits.
